





Highlights



Successfully advocated for the establishment of a \$3 million Pittsburgh Food Justice Fund.



Organized visits to Pittsburgh farms for the PA Secretary of Agriculture for 7 years running.

Highlights (Continued)



Advocated for first ever PA Farm Bill in 2019, a \$24 million investment throughout multiple programs.



Launched the Pittsburgh Food Equity Ambassadors
Program, centering the voices of Pittsburghers in
low food access areas in developing policy solutions.

Highlights (Continued)

- Led a successful advocacy campaign to establish a low income fare program, providing free and reduced transportation to SNAP recipients in Allegheny County.
- Secured the adoption of the Good Food Purchasing Policy, a values based procurement framework, at Pittsburgh Public Schools
- Worked collaboratively with the Urban Redevelopment Authority to design and establish Farm-A-Lot program
- Co-authored and passed an Urban Agriculture Ordinance for in City of Pittsburgh
- Advocated for the safe re-opening of farmers markets during COVID

Priorities for Implementation

- Support community-led efforts to address food apartheid by building resilience, community leadership, and food sovereignty.
- Evaluate food access impact of decision making at public agencies across all levels of government.
- Advocate for more affordable public transportation.
- Maximize the scope and impact of governmental anti-hunger programs.
- Support food entrepreneurship by addressing the barriers faced by women, immigrants, people of color, and other marginalized communities.

- Advocate for living wages and for the human rights of food systems workers.
- Leverage the purchasing power of large institutions to support regional producers, a valued workforce, and environmental stewardship.
- Improve access to land, land ownership, land security, and capital for farmers, especially new and beginning farmers, farmers of color, and farmers of other marginalized communities.
- Secure financial support for regional and community food systems development.

Financial Investment

- Goals:
 - Understand and address barriers to funding local food systems development
 - Increase investment in local food system
- Activities:
 - Establish and convene a Food Systems Investment Group
 - Conduct baseline assessment of current food systems funding in Pittsburgh
 - Survey PFPC members to identify barriers to accessing funding opportunities
 - Develop programming and curriculum for Food Systems Investment Group
 - Hire a grant writer to provide support to PFPC member organizations

 - Grantmakers of Western Pennsylvania
 - Bridgeway Capital
 - The Heinz Endowments
